Aging salt storage facilities run the risk of structural failure and may no longer provide adequate space for salt deliveries throughout the winter months. The Town of Clarence needed a new facility with plenty of storage space, as well as enough clearance for salt delivery trucks to drive right inside without risk of damaging the structure.

White Non-FR w/ Green Trim, Keder Panel System

10' steel leg

The concrete foundation and walls provide a durable and environmentally-sound solution for salt storage.
